How Many Angles Does A

There are two main ways to label angles: 1. give the angle a name, usually a lower-case letter like a or b, or sometimes a Greek letter like α (alpha) or θ (theta) 2. or by the three letters on the shape that define the angle, with the middle letter being where the angle actually is (its vertex).

Angles - Acute, Obtuse, Straight and Right

It has three of them. Their measures always add up to 180 degrees. A triangle has three corners, hence the prefix tri - which means 3, so 3 angles and these 3 internal angles always sum to 180 degrees. A triangle contains three (tri) angles.

How many angles does a triangle have - Answers

A pentagon has five sides and five interior angles which add up to a total of 540 degrees. To determine the number of degrees of the interior angles in a pentagon requires subtracting two from the number of sides (five) and multiplying by 180.

A polygon has as many angles as it has sides. For example, a triangle has 3 sides and 3 angles. A pentagon has 5 sides and 5 angles.

How many angles in a oval - Answers

A pentagon has 5 sides and 5 angles. The five angles add to a total of 540°. In a regular pentagon, each angle is 108°. A hexagon has 6 sides and 6 angles. The six angles add to a total of 720°. Each angle of a regular hexagon is 120°.

How many angles does a hexagon have - Answers

The angles of a regular triangle must be equal. So an obtuse triangle, if regular, would have three obtuse angles. The sum of the angles would then be greater than $3 \times 90 = 270$ degrees. But the sum of angles of a triangle must be 180 degrees.
